## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

**Site:** Dukes Meadows Dan Mason Drive, The Promenade, Riverside Drive and Promenade Approach Road London Chiswick W4 2SH

**Development:** Planning permission for the partial redevelopment of the Dukes Meadows playing fields and site of the Thames Tradesmen's Clubhouse within the wider Dukes Meadows involving: demolition of various structures within the curtilage of the rugby clubhouse together with the demolition of the existing rowing clubhouse and the demolition of the redundant public toilets on The Promenade; retention and accessibility improvements to the existing bandstand; erection of a new single storey football clubhouse on the playing fields comprising team changing rooms and social /coaching spaces, extension to the existing rugby club comprising additional team changing rooms for both rugby and hockey together with an attendant first floor rugby groundsman's dwelling, erection of a replacement two storey rowing clubhouse comprising new boat storage, changing and social spaces together with a ground floor cafe. New replacement public toilets on The Promenade. Associated external works comprising reconfigured natural grass pitches for football and rugby, floodlit and fenced artificial grass pitches for football and floodlit, partially enclosed, rugby artificial grass pitch and ancillary car parking and access improvements, wider public realm works within Dukes Meadows along Dan Mason Drive, The Promenade, Riverside Drive & Promenade Approach Road; highways and access improvements, cycle and car parking, signage, lighting, hard and soft landscape works.
